Lateness, punctuality and attendance

More and more children are being collected late this term. It is very important that you collect your children on time. Often children become anxious if they are collected late and staff need to have their full lunch break. Staff also need to be able to leave on time at the end of the day. Please also bring your child to the Nursery on time. However, if your child is late you need to take them to a member of staff so that their names can be added to the register. Letters will be going out after half-term to parents/carers who are regularly late.

Longer Day

If your child has an afternoon place, on their longer day please bring them by 10.15am. Children who are brought in at 11.00 or later are very disappointed that they only have a few minutes to play before we tidy up!

If you are coming through the entrance door at the beginning or end of the day, please make sure no child walks out without their parent, by shutting the door properly. Once children have been dismissed by the Nursery staff they are your responsibility.
