## OFSTED

E-safety is a very important issue and we are very lucky to be able to offer you this opportunity to learn about how to keep your children safe on line. ## Toys and Sweets

I'm afraid we are still having problems with children bringing sweets and toys to the nursery. We promote healthy eating at Low Hall but are finding that some children are coming in with pockets full of sweets and chocolates. Please make sure this does not happen. Some children are also still bringing their own **toys**. We have plenty of toys for the children to play with and therefore we ask you to please leave your child's toys at home.

### **Lost property**

By the end of the week we seem to have a vast array of hats, gloves, scarves and coats left in the lobby. Please write your children's names on them so that if we find them we can put them in your child's box.

### **Nappies**

If your child is still in nappies please make sure you bring in enough nappies so that your child is never left without.

### **Lateness**

It is very important that your child is brought to nursery and collected on time. If your child is brought later than 9.15am and 1.00pm please make sure you ask Mary to put your child's name in the register. If we had a fire we call the children's names from the register once they are outside and if you haven't done this we would not be aware that your child is here.

It is also very important that you collect your child on time. Doctors and dentist appointments etc. should be made so that you know you will still have plenty of time to pick up your child from nursery.

### **Buggy Park**

During the half-term break we will be having a new covered area built at the front so that there will be more space to park buggies under cover. The front of the nursery will look very different so we hope you will like the new look.
