## **School fund.**

### School Places.

The Local Authority will be sending out offer letters for school reception class places on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2014. Please could you let us know for which school your child has been allocated a place.

### Safe and Sound.

Thank you for continuing to help us place children's safety and wellbeing first by not parking on the zig zag markings outside the front gate, making sure gates are closed behind you and not blocking the fire exits with buggies. Better yet, how about leaving the buggy at home? Walking to school is great exercise and encourages your child to be more independent whilst you teach them how to be safe when walking along the street and crossing the road.

### Spare Clothing.

We will change children into dry clothes, if they get wet at the water tray, so a spare set of clothes is very useful. If you have any clothes that you no longer use, especially socks, that you would like to donate, we will gratefully accept them.

### Day care provision.

There are still day care places available at the nursery for now and in Sept 2014 . Options include 8am – 6pm, 48 weeks of the year or term time only 8am- 6pm, 8am - 3.30pm, 8am - 1pm and 1pm – 6pm.
