The government is planning to change the way it funds nursery education. These changes mean that nursery schools will no longer receive enough funding to be able to operate. By 2019 nursery schools across the country will no longer exist.

Less Funding will affect:

- The quality of the provision we offer
- Staffing ratios
- Support we can give to children with Special Education needs and disabilities.

Why SAVE nursery Schools?

- 99% of nursery schools are rated **good or outstanding**
- 65% are in our most disadvantaged areas – giving our most vulnerable under fives the **best start possible**
